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Press Release PISH

The "PISH" or "Problem-Based Learning, Intercultural Communications and STEM in Higher Education" is a European project co-funded by Erasmus+ (agreement no. 2020-1-DK01-KA203-075109) that aims to address the intercultural communication needs in the peer-to-peer learning environment of STEM students in HEIs.

The PISH project holds an innovative character as it aids the improvement of the PBL pedagogy via the design and development of online and offline solution to promote the competence of the supervisor towards facilitating intercultural communications.

PISH is guided by design thinking methodology (inspiration, ideation, implementation), developing intellectual outputs that serve actual end user needs. One of them is the PBL toolkit on Intercultural communications which is in its final stage at the time being. The produced toolkit consists of 13 tools. The toolkit is compiled by the University of Thessaly with input from project partners.

The Toolkit is expected to be published before June 2022. The toolkit provides teachers in the PBL environment with the resources students need in an intercultural environment to understand each other with emphasis on the effective collaboration with each other in their study activities.
